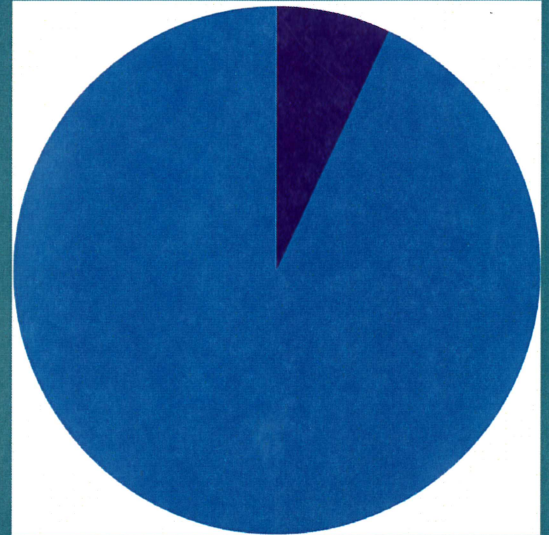
The Illinois Alluvial Regional Water Company (IARWC) wants to provide clean drinking water to **35,000** people across parts of Jersey, Madison and Macoupin Counties in Illinois. This project will give our 7 member communities more control over water resources and costs.

For this project to happen, we need your help! You're receiving this newsletter because your property will be impacted. We encourage landowners to review their easements so we can build these water lines and provide clean water to the communities that we call home.



The project pulls ground water from the IL River Bottom near Fieldon, filters the raw water through a water treatment plant, and then conveys the potable water to Carlinville. Clean drinking water hits all the member communities along the way.

WHAT'S UP WITH THE EASEMENTS?



- signed: 7%**
- not signed: 93%**

Easement offers were mailed to property owners in Fall 2022. When you sign your easement offer, this means you'll allow IARWC to cross your land while building the water lines we need to complete this community project. As soon as all the easements are signed, construction can begin.

**Our goal: 100% signed
by January 2024!**
